

UNIFORM RULES

The OCA dress code provides an environment in which students can focus on learning and faith.

MONDAY - THURSDAY

TOPS

POLOS:

- Gray, Black, or Maroon
- Must have circle crest or the embroidered Eagle mark.
 - *Old OCA shields not allowed.*

QUARTER-ZIPS:

- Gray or Black
- Must have circle crest or embroidered Eagle mark.

CREWNECKS:

- Black, Gray, Maroon
- Must have embroidered Eagle mark.
 - Purchase from Swoop Shop.
 - **NO hoodies M-Th**

OUTERWEAR:

- Cardigans, vests, jackets may be worn in the classroom if it is OCA branded with the circle crest or the embroidered Eagle mark.
 - *Old OCA shields not allowed.*

BOTTOMS

JEANS:

- Blue or black jeans.
 - *No white or colored jeans. No holes. No rips. No patterns.*

UNIFORM PANTS:

- Khaki or Black chino-style or trouser
 - *Khaki is a shade of tan, not green.*
- Button and zipper, or drawstrings accepted.
 - *No joggers or sweats.*

UNIFORM SHORTS:

- Khaki, Black, or Gray shorts, finger-tip length.
 - *Khaki is a shade of tan, not green.*
- Button and zipper, or drawstrings accepted.

SKIRTS/SKORTS:

- Pre-K through 5th Grade
 - *Skirts or skorts must be black, OCA plaid, or khaki-colored, worn with shorts or leggings of any color underneath, finger-tip length.*
- 6th through 12th Grade
 - *OCA plaid skorts must be purchased from ElynnO'Hara.*
 - **No other skirts or skorts are permitted.**
 - *Must be finger-tip length.*

ELEMENTARY DRESSES:

- Pre-K through 5th Grade girls may wear dresses sold by our partner uniform shop, ElynnO'Hara. All dresses must have the circle crest or the embroidered Eagle mark.

SHOES/HATS:

- Head coverings, caps, and hats are not allowed in the building, unless specified by OCA for a dress-out day.
- No slippers or house shoes allowed. Crocs must be in "sport mode" to be worn in secondary.
 - **NO Crocs in elementary.**

Monday-Thursday is for Academic Logos ONLY.

Sports apparel and sports logos are to be worn on Fridays *or* on Game Days (high school athletes only). Coaches will choose a uniformed outfit for HS athletes to wear on those days. Players must be identical, or teams will lose future opportunities for Game Day wear.

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FRIDAY

TOPS

T-SHIRTS:

- Students may wear any OCA-branded shirts. The shirt must clearly say "OCA," "Oklahoma Christian Academy," or have an OCA logo clearly visible. These may be academic or athletic and bought by OCA.
 - NO homemade shirts tolerated.*

SWEATSHIRTS:

- Students may wear any OCA-branded crewneck or hoodie on Fridays. These can be academic or athletic.
 - NO homemade sweatshirts tolerated.*

OUTERWEAR:

- Students may wear any OCA-branded jacket, vest, or cardigan in the classroom.
 - Any outerwear not OCA-branded must be removed in the classroom.*

BOTTOMS

CHINOS OR JEANS:

- Students may wear any bottoms listed for M-Th or they may wear black or blue jeans with holes in the knees or below.
 - NO white jeans or white skirts allowed.*

ATHLETIC WEAR:

- Students may wear an OCA-branded athletic shorts, sweatpants or joggers sold by OCA.

SHOES/HATS:

- Head coverings, caps, and hats are not allowed in the building, unless specified by OCA for a dress-out day.
- No slippers or house shoes allowed. Crocs must be in "sport mode" to be worn in secondary.
- NO Crocs in elementary.

MODESTY DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

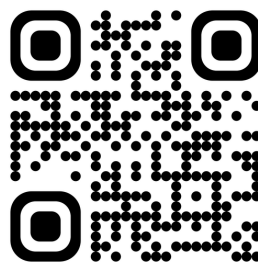
- Secondary skorts** must be purchased from our uniform partner, [FlynnO'Hara](#), and may not be rolled or altered.
 - Skorts must be finger-tip length or longer.
- Elementary skorts and skirts** may be purchased from [FlynnO'Hara](#) or other retailers.
 - Skorts and skirts must be finger-tip length or longer.
 - Modesty shorts or leggings must be worn under all skirts or dresses.
- No leggings or jeggings will be allowed, unless worn under skirts or uniform dresses.
- Boys' and girls' shorts must be finger-tip length.

UNIFORM BUYOUTS

Throughout the school year, there will be a handful of Uniform Buyouts. Students can choose to pay \$5 to wear non-OCA clothing for the day.

Proceeds will go to OCA missions. This is a great way to support our students who choose to serve with OCA.

***Students' non-OCA clothing must still meet OCA's modesty expectations listed above.**
